Meeting Minutes

February 28, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 6:33 pm by President Connie Kolodziej.

Old Business:

Hi-Note Fundraising Book: There are 21 books left from 2012. We have an invoice for \$2,812.50 for 225 books for this year. The Booster's cost for each book is \$12.50. We will discuss the selling price as well as the amount to be credited to student accounts and the Booster profit.

Ford Drive One 4 Your School: The April date was given to Young Life, so Mike is working with Hastings Ford to get a new date.

New Business:

Gertens spring sale will be held during the month of March, with orders due April 1. The sale will be open to orchestra students as well. The delivery date will be May 19. We decided to offer the annuals in 6 packs again as that seems to be what the customers want. Information will be made available at conferences next week.

There will be a meeting on Tuesday, April 9, to present the 2014 Europe trip. There will be a presentation from the travel agency, and we'll ask Jim Moline to talk about the Hi-Note books.

The MMEA Middle Level Band Festival will be held at Hastings Middle School on Friday, April 19, with 9 bands attending.

The All-District band concert will be held on Monday, March 4. The Boosters decided against sponsoring cookies and punch due to the short time frame.

We will need to acquire new leadership for Pies in the Park and the Gertens sale.
